Left Fore Fetlock: Mild to moderate medial sesamoiditis.  
Left Fore Knee: No significant findings.  
Right Fore Hoof: No significant findings.  
Right Fore Fetlock: No significant findings.  
Right Fore Knee: No significant findings.  
Left Hind Fetlock: No significant findings.  
Left Hind Hock: No significant findings.  
Left Hind Stifle: No significant findings.  
Right Hind Fetlock: No significant findings.  
Right Hind Hock: No significant findings.  
Right Hind Stifle: No significant findings.

Comment: Rating this horse as a low, moderate or high risk to develop lameness in one of the radiographed joints or areas I would currently rate this horse as a **low risk given time** to allow for sesamoidian maturation.

Clinical examination: The clinical included heart, ophthalmic eye examination, teeth examination, limb flexion and joint palpation which were normal. The horse was examined at rest and at the walk. There was no evidence of previous abdominal surgery, infection or disease, lameness, laminitis or ataxia.
