Trainer Spotlight: The Hayes Brothers Are Flying

Ben, Will, and JD Hayes are hitting their stride in spectacular fashion, proving once again why they're one of Australia's most dynamic and successful training partnerships.

Since July 1, 2024, the trio has notched an impressive 237 wins from 1,432 starts, boasting a 17% win strike rate and an excellent 43% place rate. Their form has only strengthened in recent months — in April 2025 alone, they delivered 33 winners from 157 runners (22% win, 44% place), and have continued their strong run in May, with 9 winners from 69 starts (14% win, 43% place) as of mid-month.

A standout highlight this season was **Here To Shock's** emphatic victory in the **Group 1 BCD Group Sprint (1400m)** at Te Rapa, New Zealand. This win marked the Hayes brothers' first international Group 1 triumph, showcasing their ability to prepare and campaign horses successfully on the international stage.

This consistent success and clear upward trajectory is exactly why **Slade Bloodstock proudly partners with Lindsay Park** as one of our **premier training operations**.



Racing Lowdown This month: The Why behind Gelding

Gelding is a common and important part of thoroughbred racing - but what exactly does it mean, and why do so many colts go through the process?

Gelding refers to the surgical removal of a horse's testicles, and while that might sound extreme, it's often done in the best interest of the horse's health, temperament, and racing career. Ungelded colts can be highly distracted, aggressive, or difficult to train - especially around other horses. By gelding, we're helping the horse focus, settle, and reach their full potential on the track.

It can also extend their career longevity and improve safety for both handlers and jockeys. Most colts are not destined for the breeding barn - so for most, gelding is the pathway to becoming a more manageable, happier, and ultimately more successful racehorse.

A horse may need gelding because it is getting too heavy which places more stress on their bodies in particular tendons and ligaments therefore increasing the chance of injury.

Another reason for gelding is if the testicles of the horse are large they may cause a horse to squeeze when galloping which obviously hurts and the horse will then not stride out properly or "let go".
